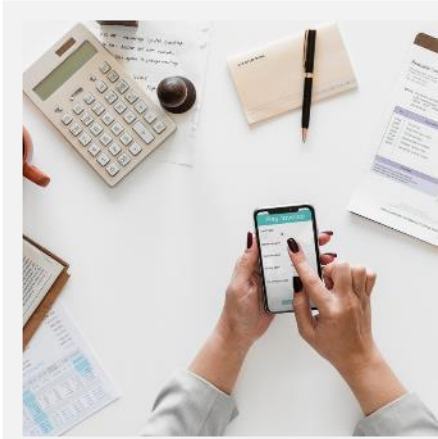

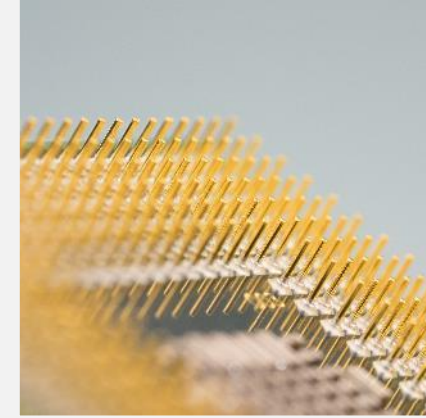

School Examples of iPad Essential Agreements and Expectations

I promise to:

- Use my iPad for the learning intention given
- Never leave my iPad unattended
- Only touch my own iPad unless the teacher asks
- Keep my iPad away from food or drinks
- Keep my hands clean before touching the iPad
- Hold my iPad with two hands while transporting it and using it
- Keep my iPad in a safe place when I am not using it
- Ensure your iPad is always above 20% battery
- Never change the settings including putting a passcode on my iPad
- Never delete or download apps
- Not remove or draw on the cover

- Use my iPad for the Learning Intention .
- Only change settings when instructed
- Keep food and drinks away from all iPads

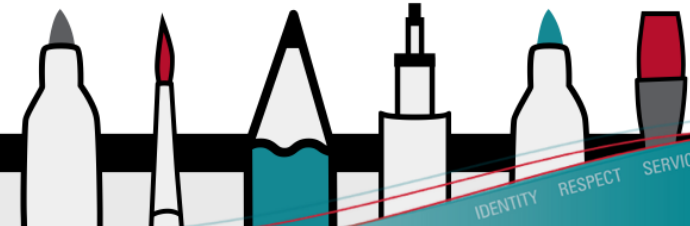

FAQS

Can I use the iPad to talk to my friends? – *No. Work device vs play device*

Who is liable if the iPad breaks at home? – *Parents are liable for the repair costs. As per the contract signed at the start of the year.*

If we are leaving the school can we buy the iPad? – *No, when a student leaves the school they will return the iPad to the ICT department*

Can we change the iPad account to our home account so we can purchase our own apps? *This option is available for when the students get to Middle school but not now in Junior school.*

Can we add and remove apps? – *Teachers add and remove apps as the iPad is managed by the school.*

Can I change the name of my iPad? – *No*

Can I back up my iPad at home? – *No*

Can I connect to my home Wi-Fi or printers? – *Yes*

What happens if I leave my iPad at home and forget to bring it to school? – *Students will not have their iPad for the day and will complete tasks in another way. We are trying to make the students responsible and accountable for their iPads therefore the front office will not accept parents bringing forgotten iPads in. If this does occur, students will not have access to their iPad for the day.*
